My input is that we need to enable work across borders whilst securing the interest of professionals in the respective countries.

I believe this is best done by linking up with a professional or firm in the other country and to share work on 50/50 basis thus each country will allow external participation in their economy whilst gaining experience and transfer of skills from outside and equally generate income to the local partner and the outsider. Thus no outsider will dominate but contribute to local developments profitably.

Allow the local professional to lead and demonstrate the usefulness of such partnerships.

If such cooperation is allowed on project by project basis, cheating is less likely to take place because word will go fast and be reported to the registration bodies thus making it difficult for such person to be invited to another partnership opportunity.
